Applicants are required to provide online notice of assignment applications no earlier than the date of release of the public notice accepting the application, and not later than five business days thereafter. You must do so by posting a conspicuous link or tab labeled "FCC Applications" on a website affiliated with the stations. The link or tab must link directly to a page containing only the announcement texts, as provided below, and remain posted for a minimum of 30 days.
